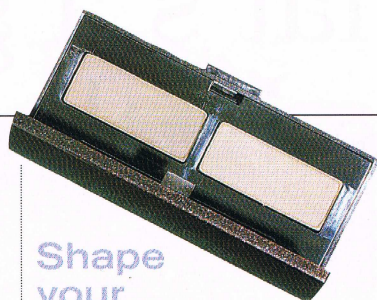

## Go easy on the eyes

When celebrity make-up artist Chrisanne Davis wants to amp up the eyes of clients such as Jennifer Lopez and Angelina Jolie, she uses metallic eyeshadow. "It reflects the light and doesn't look as heavy as a matte hue," she says. Elizabeth Arden Color Intrigue eyeshadow in Topaz (\$32; 02-8877 5000) is a versatile shade that can be smudged over the eyelid for a smoky effect.



## Shape your brows

If you're going to be bare-faced, be diligent about grooming your arches. Brow expert Nathan Williams, of Sydney's Parlour B, suggests using Laura Mercier Brow powder duo (\$45; 02-9663 4277). "The soft powder glides over the brows, leaving a much more natural finish than a pencil, plus it has great staying power," he says.



## Look wide awake

A touch of gold eyeshadow applied onto the inner corner of the eyes can really light them up, says Morgan. "I also like to use a flesh-toned pencil on the inner rim of the eyes." Try MAC eye pencil in Pale Yellow, \$28, and eyeshadow in Goldmine, \$30; 03-9825 0101.

## Refresh your face

A tinted toner like Erno Laszlo Shake-It toner (\$79; 1300 553 440) dries to a non-greasy finish and imparts colour at the same time. It dabs on in next to no time; Uma Thurman and Claudia Schiffer are fans.



## Banish an oily T-zone

Dusting your nose with powder can lead to a pasty face. A better option, says make-up artist Pati Dubroff:



"Carry blotting papers at all times." Try Chanel Oil Control tissues (\$49; at dept. stores).

## Wipe out

Dashing from the office to cocktails? Don't bother washing your entire face; a cleansing wipe will freshen skin without removing mascara, which doesn't need to be reapplied. To avoid irritating your skin choose wipes that are fragrance- and alcohol-free, such as Olay Daily Facials Express wet cleansing cloths (\$9.45; 1800 028 280).

## Be a glow-getter

For dry skin lacking in glow factor, try using a radiance-boosting skin illuminator. Morgan recommends Becca



Shimmering Skin Perfector in Pearl (\$55; 08-9381 5033).

"I blend a small amount over the face before applying foundation," she says. "The shimmer pigments shine through, so you never end up with a flat finish."
